About the Show

Strings Unbound is more than a concert—it's a statement.

Created and led by electric cellist Alex Cousins, the show blends cinematic impact with emotional honesty, reimagining iconic music from the last 50 years—from Bon Jovi and Barry Manilow to Harry Styles, Game of Thrones, and Astor Piazzolla. Backed by a full band, guest vocalists, and dancers, Strings Unbound tears down the line between classical precision and raw creative freedom.

At the center is Cousins himself—a graduate of the Peabody Institute of Music and classically trained artist with a rebellious streak, uninterested in fitting molds or staying in one lane. Each performance is rooted in a deeper pursuit: not perfection but truth. Not genre, but connection.

The result is immersive, dynamic, and deeply alive—moving seamlessly from cinematic stillness to explosive energy. There's interplay, tension, breath and release. Every moment is intentional.

Designed for theaters, festivals, and scalable venues, **Strings Unbound** is music that refuses to sit quietly—and an artist who refuses to hold back.

About Alex Cousins

Alex Cousins is a genre-bending cellist, composer, and performer redefining what the cello can be. A graduate of the world-renowned Peabody Institute of Music, he brings elite classical training to a modern, emotionally charged performance style grounded in honesty, power, and connection.

Equally at home on acoustic and electric cello, Cousins has carved out a voice that blends warmth with intensity, structure with danger. His tone is unmistakable—vocal, commanding, and deeply human.

As the creator of Strings Unbound, Cousins leads a six-piece ensemble through raw and reimagined takes on music from the last five decades—from Barry Manilow to Bon Jovi, Harry Styles and Astor Piazzolla. The show isn't about genre. It's about emotional gravity and artistic freedom.

Cousins performs with a rare kind of presence—disciplined, expressive, and unafraid to break rules in service of something real. His work challenges what the cello is supposed to be... and points instead to what it can be.
